It was an extremely difficult decision to make and was made in conjunction with the principals at St. Francis and Cathedral. We have worked hard to keep kids in cohort groups here in the building, and the mixing of St. James students with those from other schools was beginning to impact our ability to keep St. James kids in our classrooms.

The same general consideration is being given to 7th and 8th Grade MSHSAA basketball this season. The principals plan to make a decision on October 21 whether we will be able to have a season.
